The Belle Center Golf Classic Raises \$106,000

Centene Charitable Foundation presented non-profit's 19th Annual Margot Schenk Memorial tournament

ST. LOUIS – The Belle Center's 19th annual Margot Schenk Memorial Golf Classic raised more than \$106,000 for the non-profit that supports children with disabilities and their families. This year's tournament raised \$20,000 more than last year's and was held on Monday, May 9, at the Lake Forest Country Club in Lake St. Louis, Mo.

The tournament's proceeds will go toward helping The Belle Center continue to provide services for more than 350 children with disabilities, as it did for Margot Schenk, for whom the tournament was named. The Centene Charitable Foundation served
